



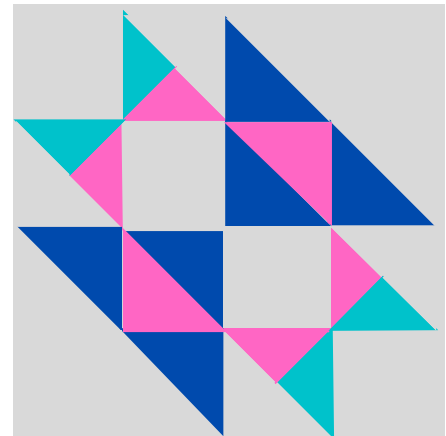


# Breezeway Quilt Block

By Mary Go Round Quilts

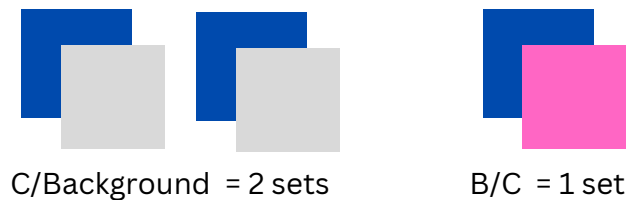
-  Fabric A (1) 5"x5" square
-  Fabric B (1) 4 ½" x 4 ½" square  
(1) 5" x 5" square
-  Fabric C (3) 4 ½" x 4 ½" squares
-  Background (6) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares  
(2) 4 ½ "x 4 ½" squares



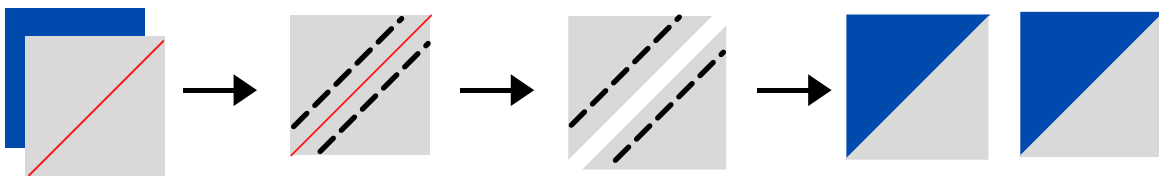
Block Size 12 ½" x 12 ½"

## 2 at-a-time Half Square Triangles (HST)

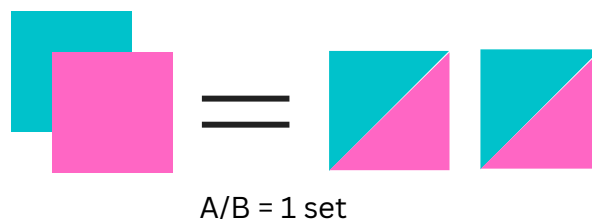
1. Pair 4 ½" x 4 ½" squares together, matching right sides.



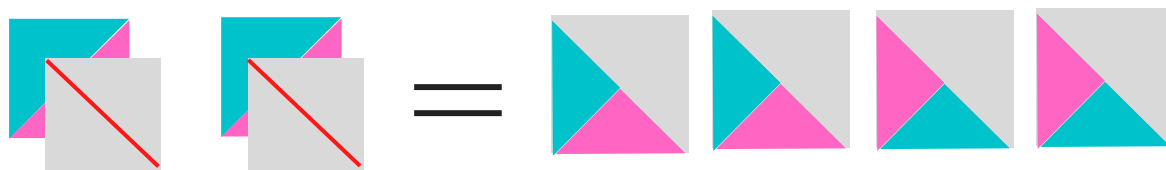
2. Draw a diagonal line on the back of one square per pair. Stitch 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Open and press seams toward darker fabric. Trim each HST to 3 ½" x 3 ½". You will have (4) C/Background HSTs and (2) B/C HSTs.



3. Pair 5" x 5" squares A /B together, matching right sides. Repeat step 2, except **trim to 4 ½" x 4 ½" square** . You will have (2) A/B HSTs.

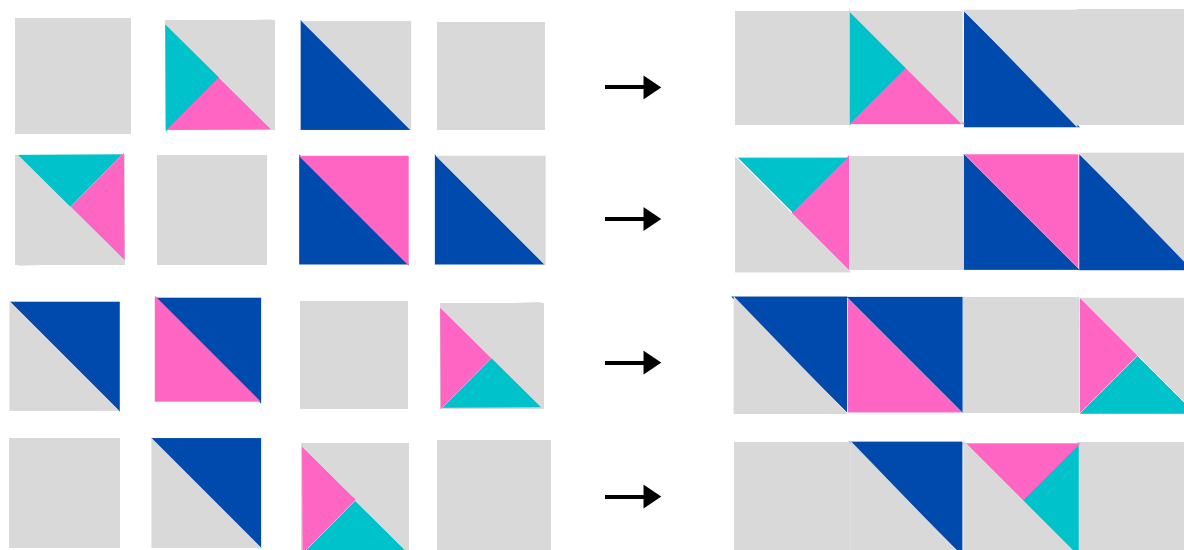


4. Place a 4 ½" x 4 ½" background square on each A/B half square triangle right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the background squares. Place marked line on background square perpendicular to A/B HST seam. Follow directions in Step 2 to make half square triangles. Press toward background. Trim to 3 ½" x 3 ½".



### Quilt Block Assembly

5. Assemble half square triangles and background squares as shown below. Sew together in rows. Press seams open.



6. Sew rows together to complete block. Press seams open.
